

Violence against displaced women

If you have left your country or are already in Spain, you may be approached by people offering you a job, humanitarian support or easy money.

Be careful! Watch out for prostitution and human trafficking networks and for people who are after your money.



Women and girls in danger of sex trafficking alert

In Spain, 75,000 persons are at risk of human trafficking for sexual exploitation. Navarra gives support to some 150 women and girls every year. Resorting to threats, the use of force or trickery, cheat and deceit with the aim of exploitation is a crime and a violation of human rights.

- **Do not hand over your documents (passports) to third persons.**
Take a backup picture of your passport to store in your email account and share it with your family and friends.
- **Do not hand over your mobile phone to third persons.**
- **Negotiate a transport fare in advance.**
- **Share your location with trusted contacts only.**
Ask the person you are travelling with to give you an address and a phone number. Also ask them to show proof of identity. Write down all vehicles' registration plates. Keep someone you trust posted on your location and travel companions.
- **Never reveal where you are in social media (Facebook, Instagram, etc.).**
Human traffickers are after this kind of information, browsing pictures and comments.
- **Think of a code word to share with your family and friends in case you are in danger.**
